
BLOOD DONATION DRIVE ORGANISED BY MITA

Blata I-Bajda, Malta – [12/11/2009]: As in previous years, the Malta Information Technology Agency (MITA) has today organised a blood donation drive in front of its offices in Blata I-Bajda. MITA is the prime Government Agency with a mandate to implement ICT policy, programmes and initiatives in Malta.
